

SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR 2022-2023

UPPER SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST (GRADES 7-12)

- o ESV Bible (English Standard Version is the recommended version clearly marked with student name)
- 1 Package of college-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper for Humanities
- o 1 Package of wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper for Math
- o Computer printer paper (for use at home)
- o 2 Binders (different colors, need to be 1 ½ inch rings)
 - o 1 binder for Humanities and 1 binder for Math/Science
 - o Will need a total of *16 divider tabs (*7th & 8th graders may need more. English will use 8 tabs)
- o 1 Binder (1-inch rings) for Spanish I and Spanish II
- Composition Book (for each class listed: 7th Life Science and Logic) 7th History and Desktop Publishing spiral notebook (50-100 sheets)
- Journal or Composition Book for 8th Bible
- o Personal size white board (7th & 8th English class)
- o 1-inch Binder and spiral notebook for Psychology
- o 2 Boxes of black dry erase markers for board work
- Personal pocket dictionary
- o 1 2-Pocket folder with brads (to be used as a general homework folder)
- o Graph paper (Math)
- o **Geometry students ONLY:** Index cards (lined) − 3 different colors (1 white and two other colors) and a quart size freezer storage bag to keep them in
- o 8 GB flash drive (minimum size)
- Backpack
- o A pencil pouch to carry to all classes to include:
 - #2 Pencils -may be mechanical
 - Blue or black pens
 - Red grading pens
 - o 5 Highlighters: Yellow, Green, Blue, Pink, Orange
 - Set of 12 Colored Pencils
 - o 6 inch ruler or 12 inch ruler (Math)
 - o 2 packages of post-it notes (size 3" x 3")
- o For 9th-12th graders **The TI-84 Plus CE Calculator** (see next page) and a **basic non-graphing scientific calculator** are required in Math and Science.
 - *9th graders in Algebra I do NOT need a calculator*
- Students will be required to purchase reading material for all English classes. The teacher will provide ISBNs in the syllabus. To avoid interruptions in study, please consider buying all course novels at the beginning of the year, well in advance of anticipated novel unit.
- Book covers must be used on all textbooks.
