REGISTRATION

Some class openings are limited to a specific number of students and age ranges. Registration for these classes is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Early registration is encouraged. Also, some classes require a minimum number of students in order to be offered. If the minimum number of registrations is not met, the class will be cancelled. Registration for the Fall semester enrichment program ends on **Wednesday, September 7th**. You will receive confirmation of your child's enrollment via email when the class has met the required number of registrations.

Enrichment programs by outside vendors may cancel or change without notice, due to unforeseen circumstances.

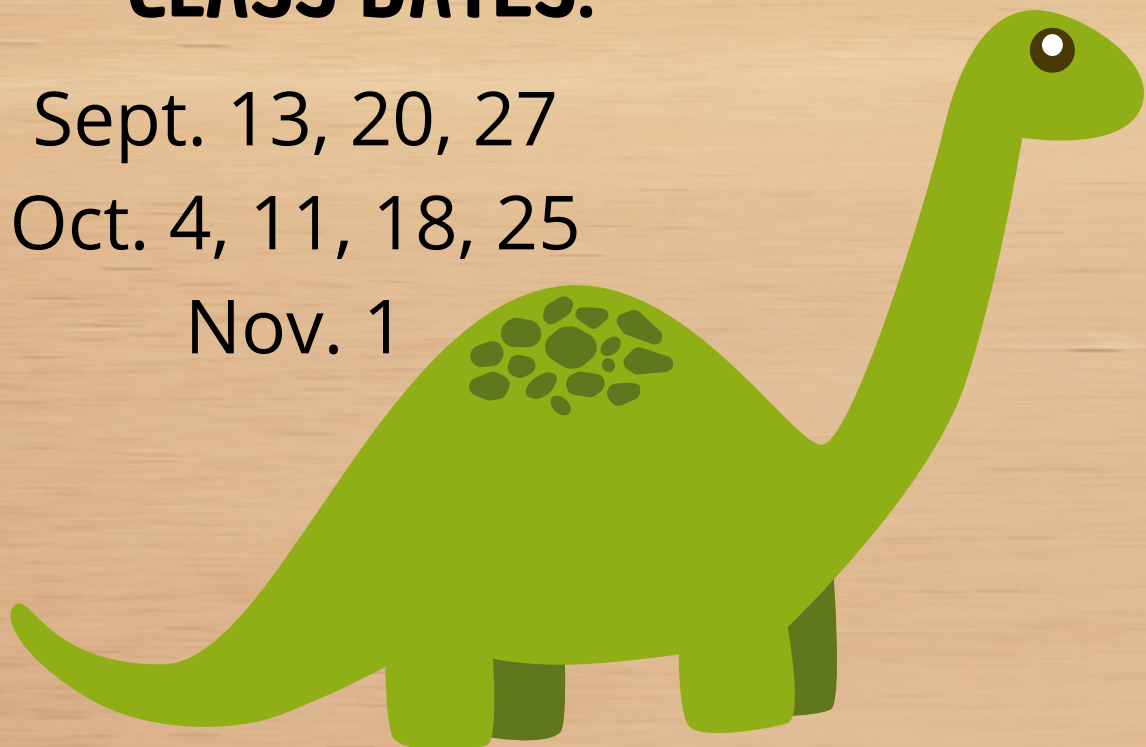
