

The Covenant Preparatory School values diversity and is pleased to offer international students desiring an education in the United States the opportunity to attend Covenant. Covenant's admission process is selective, our academic standards are high and international students are held to the same expectations as their American classmates. Proficiency in reading, writing and speaking English is essential for an international student.

Covenant is an SEVP approved school and is authorized to issue a Form I-20 for students that meet the requirements for admission and demonstrate English language proficiency. Proficiency in reading and writing in English is required.

Admission is open to International Students entering grades 8, 9, 10, and 11. Students at lower grade levels may apply if living with a relative already residing in the United States.

PLEASE NOTE: Covenant does not provide housing, transportation, host homes, medical insurance or English as a second language for international students. Proficiency in reading and writing in English is required.

Host Families

Covenant does not provide host family services for international students. If searching for a host family, you may want to explore agencies that assist with matching students with local families. If you use an agency, it is important that they are aware of our location. Covenant is located in Kingwood, a suburb of Houston, Texas. The Houston area is quite large and public transportation to Kingwood is limited. You will need to be sure that the host family lives within reasonable driving distance of the school.

One company that our students have used in the past is <u>American Homestay Network</u>. Please carefully evaluate any agency that you contract with to assist you in locating a host family.

Student Insurance

I-20 students must purchase insurance while in the United States. It is up to the student's family to purchase insurance from a provider of your choice.

International Student Fees

- Application Fee \$575.00 (Non-Refundable)
- *Registration Fee: \$2,500 International Student Fee*

*This Registration fee must be paid before the I-20 will be issued. If the student's F-1 visa is not granted, the fee will be refunded.

The Admission Process

- 1. Submit an <u>Application for Admission</u> and pay the application fee (non-refundable).
- 2. Testing:
 - All students applying for admission at Covenant must take the ISEE exam.
 - The ISEE is available internationally. For more information and to find a location near you, please <u>visit the ISEE website</u>. If there is not a school in your area that offers ISEE testing, check for a Prometric Testing <u>location</u> near you.
 - International students may be asked to provide a recent TOEFL or IELTS score report.
- 3. Submit the following documents:

Note: All documents must be translated to English:

- Copy of current passport
- Copy of transcript
- Copy of current and previous year grade report
- Teacher Recommendation Forms
 - Math Teacher Recommendation Form
 - o English Teacher Recommendation Form
- Copy of Immunization Record
- Optional Documents (must be translated to English):
 - Additional teacher letters of recommendation
 - o Additional school records, testing, personal achievements
- 4. Family Interview (will be conducted via Zoom or Google Meets if the student is overseas).

5. Upon completion of the steps above, an admission decision letter will be issued by the Admission Committee.

Enrollment

- If an offer of admission is extended, enrollment instructions will be included in the offer letter. The enrollment forms must be completed online, and the registration fee paid before the Form I-20 will be issued. The offer of admission letter will also include instructions to setup a Tuition Account to pay the International Student Registration Fee.
- 2. The I-20 form will be sent to the student via Fed-Ex or via email, depending on SEVIS rules, after the enrollment forms have been submitted and the International Student Registration Fee has been paid. The form may also be picked up from the Covenant Admission Office by appointment.
- 3. Once the student has been granted an F-1 Visa, notify Covenant's Director of Admission. You will then receive instructions for tuition payment.
- 4. Families must submit a copy of the completed I-134 Affidavit of Support and required supporting documentation to Covenant for your student's file: Affidavit: <u>https://www.uscis.gov/i-134</u>
- 5. Provide Covenant a copy of the Guardianship Agreement authorizing the host family to act on behalf of the student in all school matters, illness, or any other circumstances affecting the well-being of the student.

Tuition

The following tuition schedule has been adopted for the 2022-2023 academic year. Tuition may be paid by (1) monthly payment beginning June 2, 2022, and continuing through May 2, 2023; (2) two payments; the first on or before June 2, 2022, and the second on or before November 2, 2022; or (3) one annual payment on or before June 2, 2022. The first tuition payment is due on or before June 2, 2022, for all payment plans. If payment is not received by June 10, 2022, Covenant will be released from the obligation to guarantee your child's space.

The monthly tuition payment amount listed on this schedule is the rate for payments that begin in June. If enrolling in July or August and choosing the monthly payment plan, the tuition for the missed months (June and/or July) plus month of enrollment must be paid in one lump sum in order to become current with the 12-month payment plan.

Advanced Placement Courses may be assessed textbook and testing fees. Non-consumable books and materials remain the property of Covenant. Special trips, student pictures, athletic fees, $5^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade field trips, and fellowship activities are not included in the fee schedule.

Covenant has designated funds for *partial* financial aid for each academic year. These funds will be awarded based on annual budget and financial need. Applications for financial assistance must be completed online. Go to <u>www.covenantknights.org</u>. Click on *Admission* then *Tuition and Fees*. Click on the FAST logo near the bottom of the page. Returning students must be re-enrolled prior to applying for financial assistance. New students may apply for tuition assistance once application has been made. All applications will be held in strict confidence. Financial assistance award notifications will be made by the Business Office Manager.

The overhead expenses of the school do not diminish with the withdrawal of some students. Families accept the obligation to pay the published tuition rate and no portion of tuition paid up to the date of withdrawal will be returned for any student withdrawing from Covenant before the completion of the academic year.

Students who are not in compliance with financial, academic, disciplinary, state immunization requirements and school policies may be denied continued enrollment or placed on probation and subject to evaluation at the end of each grading period.
